GAINS THE INTERNATIONAL RECOGNITION



Alwa 2009, the Cabernet Sauvignon-based wine that Viña Anakena released earlier this year, has earned overwhelming approval by both winewriters and wine lovers alike.

Two months prior to its launch Alwa 2009 was presented at the Annual Wines of Chile Awards 2012, where international judges such as Debra Meiburg MW from Hong Kong, Lisa Perrrotti MW of Singapore, Peter Richards MW of UK, Anthony Gismondi of Canada, and Bill St. John of the USA, awarded with a

Gold Medal. It has been reaping praise from different media ever since for its elegance and balance as well as its perfect fusion of fruit and oak.

Alwa 2009 comes from the Cachapoal Valley, where Viña Anakena has two vineyards. One is in Alto Cachapoal, where the winery is located very close to the Andes Mountains, and the other, the Las Cabras Vineyard, is in the outstanding Peumo sector in the middle of the valley.

Winemaker's Notes

A red-ruby color wine, with violet highlights. On the nose it is a complex wine with lush red fruit flavours and floral notes, that suggest violets and lavender. A great complexity on the palate with fresh black and red fruit notes, intermingled with pepper and caramel. The fine and velvety tannins complemented with an excellent acidity, brings out the freshness and balance of this silky wine.

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
