## ANAKENA WINES ONCE AGAIN AMONG THE BEST

More than 600 wines from Australia, New Zealand, South Africa, USA, Argentina, and Chile participated in the 2014 Six Nations Wine Challenge, held in Sydney, Australia. Anakena earned two Gold Medals and was one of just 11 Chilean wineries to do so.

Each country presented 100 wines, which were previously selected for participation by a wine critic from the respective country. Eduardo Brethauer, Editor of Vitis Magazine, chose the wines for Chile.

ONA White Blend 2013, is a complex and elegant blend of Riesling, Chardonnay and Viognier offers a beautiful straw-yellow color with extraordinary aromatic intensity. The nose presents mineral notes from the Riesling, tropical fragrance of Chardonnay and floral and peach aromas from the Viognier that combine in magnificent harmony on the finish. A refreshing and well-balanced wine with crisp acidity and a persistent finish. Ideal with salads, shellfish, and risotto.

TAMA Viognier 2013, a golden - straw colored, this fresh and well - balanced Viognier exhibits intense aromas of peach and pears, along with floral notes recalling violets. Ideal with pastas, soups, fish, and shellfish.
